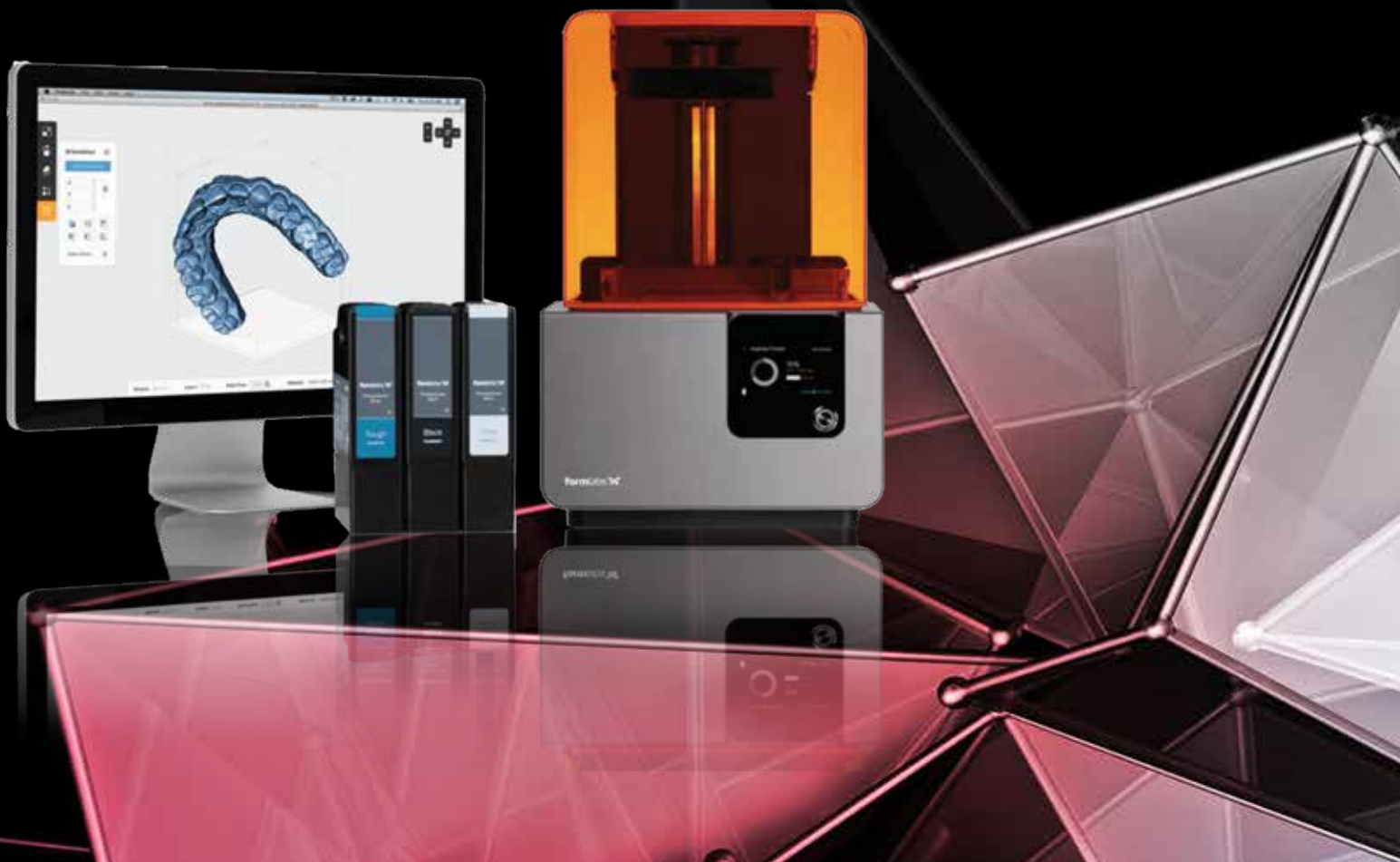
COURSE OVERVIEW

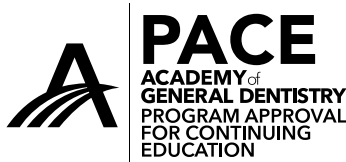
