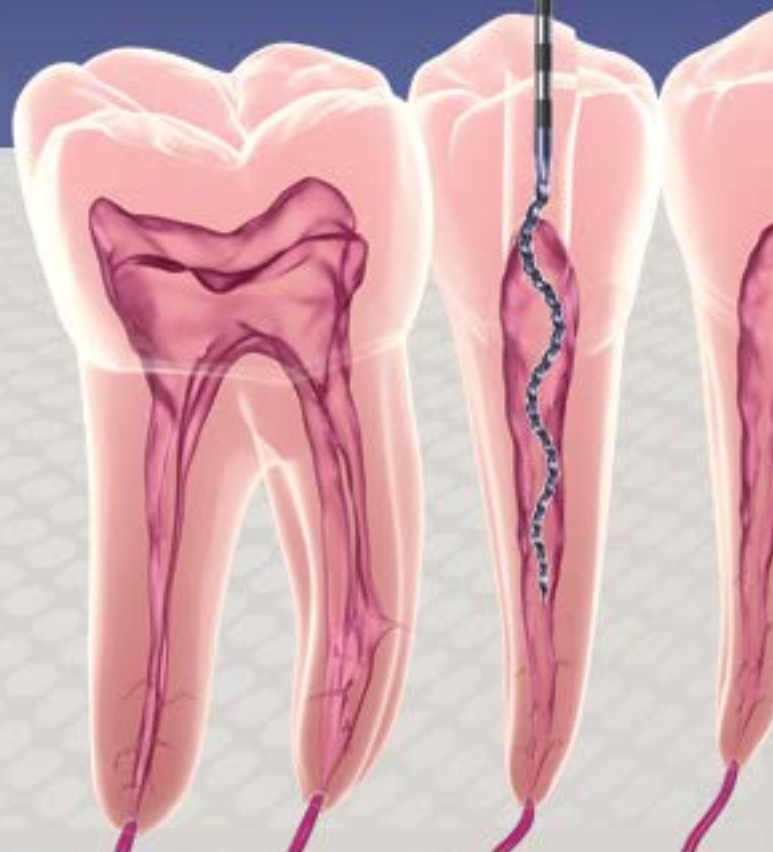

COURSE OVERVIEW

The paramount aim of the course is to enable the participant to perform the full scope of endodontic procedures and to understand endodontic biologic principles in order to evaluate new instruments and techniques and to evolve along with the revolutionary and evolutionary changes in the discipline.


PROGRAM DETAILS

DAY 1:

- Biologic foundation of endodontics; the biologic science behind predictable success
- Access; the fundamental requirements for access are reviewed and basic rules for adequate access presented. Minimal but adequate access is the ultimate aim!!!!
- Fundamentals of the dental operating microscope

DAY 2:

- Anatomic instrumentation and passive obturation
- Live patient demonstration



Attendees are asked to bring 6 extracted teeth with half of them accessed for endodontic treatment.

Dr. Martin Trope was born in Johannesburg, South Africa and received his BDS degree in dentistry in 1976. In 1980 he moved to Philadelphia to specialize in Endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania. In 1989, he became Chair of Endodontology at Temple University. In 1993 he accepted the JB Freedland Professorship at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Dr. Trope is Clinical Professor, Department of Endodontics, University of Pennsylvania and in private practice.
